



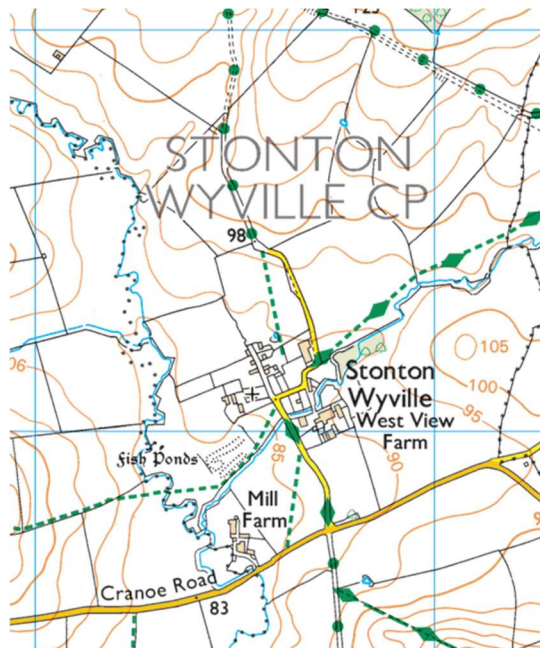
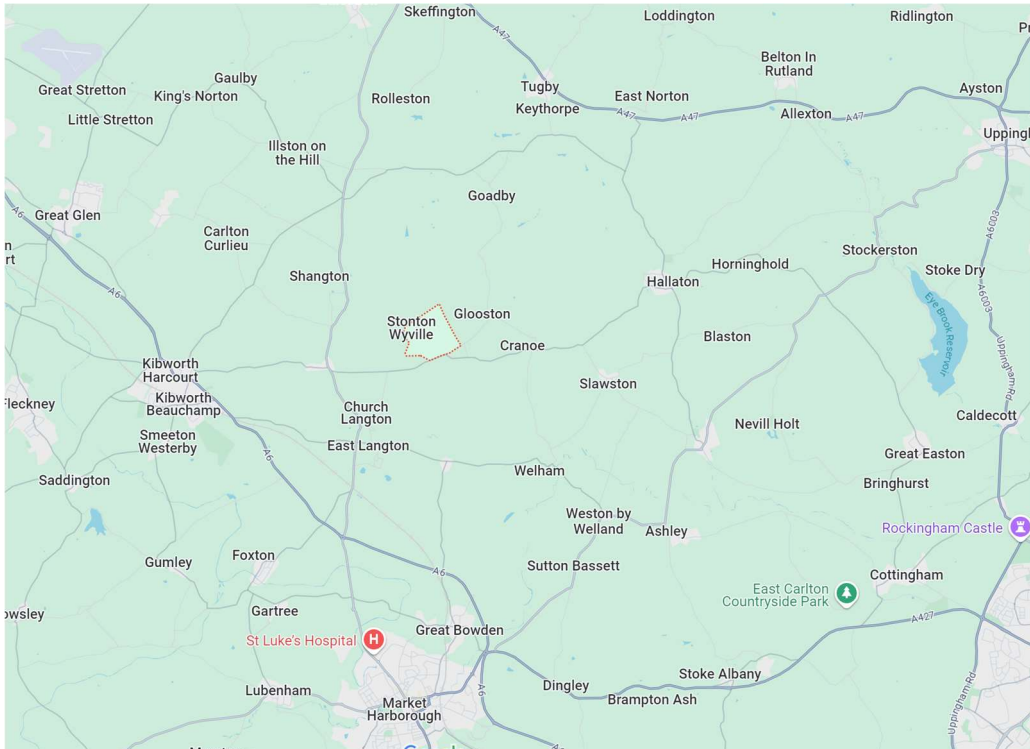

[There are several Judges & Helpers group within the Community, if you are bringing a helper please encourage them to join it as it's a great way of communicating with them all. Only those judging on Saturday will be approved to join the [Saturday Judges and Helpers group](#), please don't ask to join it if you are riding as Helen will decline your request.

Riders who are helping on Sunday will be able to join the [Sunday Judges and Helpers group](#), which will be closed to posts until Sunday morning.]

Venue Plan



A = Secretary / Parking steward / temporary corrals / map room / scorer / event shelters (where Saturday night meal will be served)

Please report to the Parking Steward when you arrive. There is a ditch on the way into the corralling area (marked on the plan, above) that is sufficiently deep that horses will be better to walk through than be driven through in a vehicle (Helen's Mitsubishi Shogun and Ifor 506 went through fine but the jockey wheel did touch in the bottom so horses probably wouldn't enjoy it). There will be 2-3 temporary corrals in the eastern part of the field which can be used to unload horses into on arrival. Once your horse is unloaded, drive your vehicle through the dip and then walk back to fetch your horse once you have parked (before corral building). Please use the temporary corrals for as short a time period as possible.

The corralling field has no piped water supply but a water bowser will be available in the corralling area of the field for horses and washing. Please bring Human Drinking water with you.

There will also be a trailer for muck in the corralling area of the field. This is only for horse poo, waste hay and waste bedding.

Dogs on leads are allowed but ALL DOG POO **MUST** be bagged up and taken home. The corralling field is used for livestock grazing and dog poo can spread diseases to farm livestock. Any dogs seen off leads will be subject to a Compulsory Donation to charity of £15 and any rider / judge persistently letting their dog(s) cause a nuisance may be asked to leave the venue immediately.

The area edged in red on the venue plan is a scheduled ancient monument, please take care when walking across it so that we don't damage it.

Please check in at the Secretary soonest to collect your **wristbands** (one each for you and your horse) and your **bib number** for Sunday.

Bring your **Hat(s)** to be checked (and labelled if it hasn't yet been). Also bring your **Body Protector** to be checked but that won't be labelled.

Thanks to our sponsors Welland Valley Feeds, who have kindly donated prizes for some of the classes.

Riding on Friday ...

Turn south out of the event field, ride along the road and cross the Tur Langton to Cranoe Road with care. Use the byway to Thorpe Langton (through the ford) or the bridleway to Welham – you can use these to make a very nice circular route or go and come back the same way.

POR

Hats must be checked and labelled at the Secretary Station before Tack Check.

ALL gates **MUST** be correctly fastened shut (unless they are clearly intended to be left open) as there is livestock in the area which must remain in the correct places.

Levels 2A-4 may be asked to navigate using grid references and/or bearings. Please note that bearings will be quoted in the correct format (3-digit numbers without degree signs) as they are bearings, not angles. Please ask Helen if you need further explanation about this (preferably before Saturday morning or after the POR has finished...)

PTV

All in one field within easy walking reach of the corralling field (next door field). Fixed obstacles will be included so **body protectors** are **required** and will be checked at the start – make sure your Blue/Turquoise 2018 label is visible when you are riding or be prepared to get off to demonstrate it.

It is intended that the PTV course will be open for walking from 7pm until 10pm Friday. A message will be put onto the Riders WhatsApp group when it has been approved.

Obstacle numbers will follow the usual system: L4 = red, L3 = blue, L2&2A = yellow. Time limits will be published via WhatsApp when they are ready, but the starter will also know the correct time limit so ask before starting if needed.

We would be delighted to receive offers from riders to judge other level(s) on Sunday, to supplement the helper team. Judges will be provided with a 'helper lunch'. Please mention this to the secretary when getting your hat labelled if you are willing to help. Full judging help will be given for those less experienced at TREC, all that is needed is a pair of working eyes and the ability to note down what they see.
